### General definition

The two most common forms to refer to the future are will or going to. Often, especially in casual speech, these forms are used interchangeably with no problem. However, in formal writing there are slightly distinctions. Will is more commonly used with recent decisions, certain futures and predictions. Going to tends to be used about events that were previously decided on.
